They join the Board of Director and Secretary General Lucie Mattera, in leading the association and its work.

The governance focused Management Committee will be chaired by a smiling new face in the Association, Zuzana Púčiková, who recently joined Netherlands-based EVBox as its Director of Policy for Europe. She will work closely with our Board President Remco Samuels, CEO of EVBox.

*"I'm excited to join the ChargeUp Europe team and help drive industry collaboration which is crucial to seizing this decisive decade to decarbonize transport," says Púčiková about her new role. The Policy Committee is Chaired by Jayson Dong Senior Manager, Public Policy – EU at Chargepoint. The vice chair is Erno Scheers, head of Global EV Policy at Shell, who was re-elected for a second term as vice chair.

*"2023 is a critical year for e-mobility as we will finally have an agreement at EU level on the AFIR but swift implementation at Member State level will be equally as important. At the same time, I look forward to continuing our work on some of the other key priorities for ChargeUp including the review of the Co2 emissions for heavy duty vehicles file, grid connection and permitting as well as the electricity market design," Dong elaborated.*

Aaron Fishbone, Policy Director at Poland based GreenWay, was reelected as Chair of the Communications Committee, and Alan Augusto, from Portugal based edp, was elected as vice-chair.

According to Fishbone: *"EV charging brings together a lot of previously distinct topics – transport, energy, IT – in a dynamic and quickly evolving way. As more and more people and businesses go electric, we need to be communicating clearly to them, as well as policymakers and regulators, how the business and whole ecosystem works. It's an exciting challenge which, along with the great colleagues, is what makes working in this space so rewarding."*

Secretary General Lucie Mattera elaborated on ChargeUp Europe's role as a thought leader and coalition partner, "We have an incredibly strong slate of Committee leads, with committed and creative experts who will help drive our work. I look forward to delivering our 2023 work plan with them and building the partnerships and collaborative initiatives to support our policy objectives."
